Las Ramblas, Barcelona's most famous street is both a tourist magnet

and a window into Catalan culture, with cultural centres, theatres and architecturally intriguing buildings lining its sides. Set between narrow traffic lanes and flanked by plane trees, the middle of La Rambla is a broad pedestrian boulevard, crowded every day until the small hours with a wide cross section of society. A stroll will enchant you with souvenir hawkers, buskers, pavement artists, mimes and living statues all part of the ever-changing street scene.

It takes its name from a seasonal stream (raml in Arabic) that once ran here. Unofficially, La Rambla is divided into five sections, which explains why many know it as Las Ramblas.
